## **Application for an export licence for ponies (including horses) OF 147 cms (14.2 hands) or less**

2. The application must be accompanied by either:
  - proof that the pony meets the minimum value levels such as a current insurance note, or purchase invoice. If such proof cannot be provided then;
  - A Certificate of Minimum Value (EXH 4) obtained from a Valuer or, alternatively a Judge of a Breed Society (listed in the Departments' "Guidance Notes" EXH12) in whose Stud Book the pony is listed. The Valuer or Judge must be selected from a list obtainable from the address given above;  
**OR**
  - a Declaration from an officer of an international competition organisation (EXH 5) stating that the pony is being exported to take part in, or having taken part in, an official international competition.
3. Exporters are reminded of the need to comply with the animal health requirements of the importing country and of any other country of transit. Information concerning health requirements of the importing country may be obtained from the Regional Operations Director responsible for the premises of origin. Further guidance is available from the International Animal Health Service Delivery Unit (tel: 01522 563132). Advice on whether you require a journey log is available from the Welfare In Transport Section (tel: 0845 603 8395).
4. Before you start to complete the application form, please read the Guidance Notes for Exporters (EXH 12).

**Please submit this application form at least 7 days before the intended date of travel. Applications received with less notice will be processed as quickly as possible but no guarantees can be given that the licence will be issued in time for the intended journey.**

I understand that the pony/ponies will require to be rested before shipment at approved premises\* in accordance with the Export of Horses (Protection) Order 1969 unless the Licence issued in response to this application grants exemption from that requirement. I acknowledge that if such an exemption is not granted I am responsible for making arrangements at my own expense for the detention of the pony/ponies at approved premises.

I declare to the best of my knowledge and belief the particulars given above and in the Schedule are correct.

I understand that if a licence is issued this does not confer any consent or approval that maybe required under any other regulations in connection with this export.
